### E. Grants-in-Aid

During the year (2015-16) the University had received total grants under Plan and Nonplan head of ₹10357.43 lakh. Out of the total grants (₹10357.43 lakh) the University had spent ₹10357.43 lakh. Internal Auditing System is inadequate due to the following:

- 1. No Internal Audit Manual was in use.
- The post of the Internal Audit Officer was vacant throughout the year.  $\ddot{c}$
- Internal Audit conducted by the C.A. firm in 2015-16 did not involve the scrutiny of all the activities of the University. 3

## B. Adequacy of Internal Control System

Internal Control System is inadequate in the following areas:

- It appeared that the University did not have any mechanism to adjust the long pending advances paid to the Staffs in respect of externally sponsored projects.
- Fees directly deposited to Bank were not accounted for immediately. 7
- Sundry items such as interests, internal receipts etc. were not regularly checked by responsible officers to ensure that correctness of the amounts received. 3
- not verified and signed by the D.D.O. Bank Reconciliation contained entries like The University did not prepare the Cash Book as per guideline, the opening and Even the monthly cash and bank closing balances were not worked out and the same were 'Withdrawal not recorded in cash book' and 'Cash deposited, not recorded in cash book'.
