### Minutes (Draft)

The Chairman welcomed members and requested the Director Prof B K Konwar to make presentations as per the agenda.

Confirmation of the minutes of the last QAC meeting dated 16.10.09: The minutes of the meeting was circulated to all members. No comments are received from members, as such the meeting confirmed acceptance of the minutes.

# Action Taken Report: The ATR was presented in order of resolutions adopted in the last QAC meeting:

### Presentation of the secretarial report

The secretarial report was presented by the Director, IQAC. The report described the following:

Self Appraisal Report (SAR) and NAAC visit: The IQAC has prepared the SAR for the last five years, 2004-2009 to submit to the NAAC for re-assessment/re-accreditation of the University. In the last assessment and accreditation covering the period 1999 – 2004, the University could secure grade B<sup>+</sup>.

Following the submission of the SAR 2004-09, the NAAC has appointed a visiting committee of seven members under the Chairperson Prof. L. K. Maheswari, Former VC, BITS, Pilani. The period of visit has been finalized to be 25<sup>th</sup> – 28<sup>th</sup> October 2010. The visiting team will arrive at the University on 24<sup>th</sup> October 2010. The list of visiting team is handed over to all members.

On the first day (25<sup>th</sup> October 2010) at 10-30 to 11 am, The Director, IQAC, Tezpur University has to make a brief presentation to the NAAC visiting team on Quality Related Activities of the University. The presentation will be followed by discussion with the members of the QAC, IQAC. Both Chairman and Director invited QAC members, more specifically the External ones to be present in the said discussion on the specified date and time.

Submission of the Annual Report 2009-10: The Annual Report for the year 2009-10 was prepared and submitted to the NAAC.

School level Faculty Seminar: With the objective to encourage collaborative research and teaching, the school of Science & Technology has been organizing Faculty Seminar on every alternate Friday since September, 2009. Annual Report has to be submitted to the Academic Council Meeting. Efforts are on to cover Ph D scholars as well.

Academic and administrative audit: A committee comprising of six external academicians/scientists and seven internal faculty members carried out Academic and Administrative Audit of the University on 25<sup>th</sup> to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2010. The experts visited each and every Department, Center and Section of the University and discussed at length with Faculty Members, Officials, Staff Members, Ph D Scholars and Students. They submitted a detailed report expressing satisfaction on overall progress of the University.

Student achievements in Co-curricular activities: In the last East zone Inter-university meet, held at Kalyani University, West Bengal, students representing Tezpur University bagged five awards: Gold Medal (Joint) Debate, Silver Medal Spot Photography, Silver Medal in Western Group Music, Bronze Medal Western Solo Music, and Best Literary Team.

At the end, the Director briefly described about the hostels and quarters (faculty and employees) under construction, shifting of Health Center to the newly constructed two story building and satisfactory performance of students in the last NET-Lect/JRF, DBT-JRF (20) and GATE (25).

#### Resolutions

The following resolutions were adopted in the meeting:

01. Permanent branch of the State Bank of India and full fledged Post Office with foreign services in the University campus.

The VC stated that steps have been initiated to establish a permanent branch of the State Bank of India in the campus. Regarding the post office necessary formalities will be done.

02. Appointment of more nurses, technical personnel and helpers in the University Health Center.

On the basis of non-faculty positions obtained from the UGC, effort will be made to appoint at least one nurse and one lab technician.

03. Effective waste disposal system

The VC stated about a tie with LGBRIMH, Tezpur for effective disposal of nonradioactive lab wastes in their facility. He also opined on adoption of effective measures for the collection of household garbage.

04. Provision of benefit to trained fourth grade employees

The authority stated to do the needful.

05. Separate provision of fund for practical classes of integrated M. Sc. programs

Presently, practical classes of integrated M Sc programs (Maths, Chem, Phy and Bosci & Bioinf) are conducted using chemicals and glass-wares of general courses. This creates lots of hardships.

It was stated to provide fund on receipt of advance requisitions by the concerned

Departments.

- 06. Effective utilization of vacant Assam type buildings Following shifting of Departments and Offices to new buildings, some AT buildings are lying vacant. Effort may be made to allot these buildings to offices like TUEE, Patent Cell etc.
- 07. Provision for cycle stands and car parks in hostels and departments
  With the increased student strength circlers have increased tremendously. In the
  campus number of cars has also increased significantly. Hence, there is a need of for
  bicycle stands in hostel and office premises. Similarly, car parks may also be
  constructed.
- 08. Conservation of electricity and proper use of treated water

  Participating in the discussion, the external member Dr (Ms) Dutta suggested adoption of effective measures to prevent wastage of electricity and treated water. The guilty offices, sections, departments and hostels may be notified repeatedly to develop a practice.

09. More spaces, if possible new buildings may be provided to the Dept of Math Sci and Physics.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to and from the chair.
