Former Indian High Commissioner to UK Interacts with Students at Tezpur Varsity

Tezpur, April 24: Attending the prize distribution ceremony of Bimal Bhagwati and Bijoy Chandra Bhagwati Memorial Essay Competition, 2017, organized by Tezpur University, Dr. Jaimini Bhagwati, former Indian High Commissioner to UK interacted with the students of the University and exchanged newer ideas and thoughts vis-à-vis the rapidly changing world.

A total of 59 essays were received in both the categories and they were evaluated on the basis of 10 parameters followed by thorough checking with the help of anti-plagiarism software. Mr. Abhilek Saikia and Ms. Himashri Sarmah won the Bijoy Chandra Bhagwati essay competition while Ms. Priyanka Acharya and Ms. Sonal Sidhu K. Sharma won the other prize.

Speaking on the occasion, Vice Chancellor, Prof. Mihir K. Chaudhuri expressed his hope that the essay competition would be an annual event and urged the winning students not to focus on the prize money but on the recognition they have received.
