**Qualification:** M.Sc. in Biotechnology/ Life Sciences with sufficient training and experiences in the field of Molecular Biology/Virology. NET-JRF qualified candidate shall be given preference.

**Duration:** Two years or co-terminus with the project.

**Fellowship:** Rs. 16,000/- (Rupees sixteen thousand) only + 10% HRA per month if candidate is NET/GATE/BET/BINC qualified. Otherwise it shall be Rs. 12,000/- (Rupees twelve thousand) only + 10% HRA per month for the candidate with NET-LS or without NET/GATE/BET/BINC.

**Age:** Candidate should not be more than **28 years** of age as on the date of interview. The upper age limit may be relaxed up to **5 years** in the case of candidates belonging to SC/ST/OBC/Women and physically challenged.
