Selection will be made on the basis of performance in the Written Admission Test conducted by the concerned department.

How to apply:

Eligible candidates may **APPLY ONLINE** through the University Website by paying a fee of Rs. 250/- by the candidates of SC, ST & PWD categories and Rs. 500/- by the candidates of OBC_NCL category (additional bank charge may apply). Candidates should read and follow the instructions available on the Tezpur University website carefully while filling in the relevant columns of the online application form. Payment is to be made online using either credit card, or debit card, or net-banking. The transaction detail is to be printed and preserved for later reference.

The candidates may report to the concerned Head of the Department at 9.30 a.m. on 14th August, 2015 for Admission Test. They should bring self attested copies of mark sheets, certificates of all examinations, SC/ST/OBC(NCL)/PWD certificate, wherever applicable, character certificate issued by the institution last attended in the respective Department at the time of reporting for the Admission Test on 14.8.2015. The candidates are also required to produce original certificates, mark sheets and other documents. Selected candidates will be admitted on the same day and they will be required to deposit prescribed amount of admission fees at time of admission. **No separate call letters will be sent.**
