(PG) SC509: Population and Society

Course Objective:

Course Objective:

This course seeks to develop the students an understanding of the Indian society and its various features. It explains some important processes of social change in India. It also deals with the distinctive nature of Indian society like unity in diversity, religion, language and so on.

(PhD) SC726: Philosophy and Social Research

Course Objective:

The course provides an exposure to the fundamentals of social science research methodology, the debates and discourses on the history and the nature of science. This course aims to familiarise the students to the different approaches and orientations in understanding and explaining social phenomena such as the basic subjectivity-objectivity debate.
