This is for information of all concerned that the following courses will be offered for the **Autumn Semester, 2018** as CBCT/ Open Elective. The Heads of the Departments / Centres/ Cells are requested to advise the students for ONLINE registration of the course from the pool of the courses given below.

The courses will be treated as Open Electives for the students admitted in the year 2017 and it will be governed by the guidelines of Open electives. The courses for the students admitted earlier will be considered as CBCT. Students should submit their choice list of courses in multiple numbers in order of their preferences. However, only one course will be allotted to a student based the availability of seat and his/her preference. In this process efforts will be made to allot the course of first preference but still some students may be allotted second or third choice.

Online registration of the CBCT/ Open elective courses will be considered as first come first serve basis. Students will be able to login during 19-22 May, 2018 to the registration portal by using their Proxy server ID and password through the link: <http://chitrlekha.tezu.ernet.in/tucoursereg>. The link will be activated at 6.00 p.m on 19.05.2018 and they can register the course or change their choices till 12.00 midnight on 22.05.2018.

Students can select and add the courses in the portal as per their choice in the list. After adding a course to his/her choice list, he/she can reorder the courses using the respective button available but the courses can not be removed from the list.

During 23rd -25th May, 2018, the faculty member or staff authorized by the Head of the Department / Centre shall verify the courses registered by the students based on pre- requisites and other condition of the Department. COE office will consider for final allotment as Open elective/ CBCT course only after verification by the Department.

The CoE office will allot the course on 26th May, 2018 onwards and arrange to upload the list of students with registered courses on the website in the first week of June for information of the students.

The classes of the CBCT/ Open elective courses will be held in the existing slot of CBCT i.e. from 9:10 a.m. to 10:10 a.m. and from 2:30 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. on Tuesday, Wednesday and Friday.
