Tezpur University Rules for selection of Best Graduate Award

(Approved by the 36th meeting of Academic Council held on 27th September, 2019)

The **Best Graduate Award** shall be awarded to a student passing out of a graduate degree programme of the University with academic distinction and excellence in co-curricular activities during programme of study. The award shall be judged based on display of both high levels of **academic**, **extra and co-curricular activities**.

1. Rules for selection:

1.1 Eligibility

A student shall be eligible for consideration for the award provided-

- I. He/she secures a CGPA of 8 or above.
- II. He/she has not secured any 'F' grade during the programme of study in the University.
- III. He/she was not placed under academic probation during programme of study in the university.
- IV. Completes the programme within the specified minimum number of semesters, and
- V. Does not have any record of disciplinary action against him/her during programme of study in the University.

1.2 Performance Score:

The weightage of the performance score (P) shall be 75 % in academic (A) and 25% in extra and co-curricular activities (E). The performances score is given by-

$$P = \frac{A}{10} \times 75 + \frac{E}{10} \times 25$$

Where A is the score on academic performance given by CGPA attained and E is the score on extra and co-curricular activities attained in a 10-point scale.

1.2.1 Score on extra and co-curricular activities:

The score 'E' shall be calculated by two sub-components –

SCOL - Sports, Cultural, Organisational and Leadership activities:

IP - Intellectual and Professional activities.

The Scores on the two subcomponents shall evaluate the score 'E' as-

$$E = \frac{(SCOL + IP)}{2}$$

The scores on the subcomponents shall be as per the table shown in Table I & II.

1.3 Conditions on scores:

The scores shall be calculated subject to the following conditions-

- I) The scores against each activity if represented the University, shall be during the period of the academic programme only.
- II) The maximum score in a subcomponent -SCOL or IP shall be 10 i.e. only one award received in an event shall be counted (For example if a student publishes two papers in reputed journals the score shall be 10, not 20)
- III) In case of a tie, the score on academic performance (A) i.e. given by CGPA shall be the deciding score.

2. Procedure:

The following procedure shall be followed for selection of best graduate award-

- i) The CoE shall notify for the outgoing batch of students to submit the proof of the records of their achievements in SCOL and IP through the HoD of the Dept.
- ii) The CoE shall prepare the list of eligible students and compile the information on SCOL and IP, and
- iii) The list along with the compiled information with proof of records shall be forwarded to the committee with DSW as Chairman constituted for selection of the Best Graduate of the year. Then committee shall send its recommendation to the AC for approval.

Tezpur University Rules for selection T & I Best Postgraduate Award

(Approved by the 36th meeting of Academic Council held on 27th September, 2019)

The **T & I Best Postgraduate Award** shall be given to a student passing out of a postgraduate degree programme of the University with academic distinction during a year. It is desirable that the best postgraduate of the University not only be academically brilliant, he/she also displays high capability and personality in terms of extra and co-curricular activities. Therefore, the award shall be given based on an all-round performance score that gives 75% weight to academic performance and 25% weight to performance in extra & co-curricular activities as follows:

Performance Score,
$$P = \frac{A}{10} \times 75 + \frac{E}{10} \times 25$$

Where, A is the academic performance score given by the CGPA secured, and E is the extra & co-curricular score assigned to the incumbent in a 10-point scale.

Eligibility

A student shall be eligible for consideration for the award provided-

- I. He/she secures a CGPA of 8 or above.
- II. He/she has not secured any 'F' grade during the programme of study in the University.
- III. He/she was not placed under academic probation during programme of study in the university.
- IV. Completes the programme within the specified minimum number of semesters, and
- V. Does not have any record of disciplinary action against him/her during programme of study in the University.

The E component shall have two sub-components: Sports & Cultural (SC) and Intellectual & Professional (IP). These two subcomponents shall also be assigned scores in the 10-point scale and shall sum up to E as:

$$E = \frac{(SC + IP)}{2}$$

The assignment of the scores for SC and IP shall be made as per the tables below:

The scores on the subcomponents shall be as per the table shown in Table I

Note:

- i. The scores against each activity if represented the University, shall be during the period of the academic programme only.
- ii. If a student receives award in more than one event, the scores in these will be added up. However, the maximum score of a student in a subcomponent (SC/IP) shall be 10.
- iii. If a student receives award in an event more than once only, one of these will be counted.

Procedure:

The following procedure shall be followed for selection of best graduate award:

- I. The CoE shall notify for the outgoing batch of students to submit the proof of the records of their achievements in extra & co-curricular activities before leaving the University.
- II. The CoE shall prepare the list of eligible students and compile the information on extra & co-curricular achievements of these students.

III. The list along with the compiled information with proof of records shall be forwarded to the committee with DSW as Chairman constituted for selection of the T & I Best Postgraduate of the year. The committee shall send its recommendation to the Academic Council for approval.
