- Meaning and different types of assessment technique.



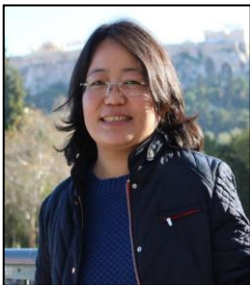
