

National Education Day on November 11, 2023

REPORT

Department of Education, Tezpur University celebrated National Education Day on 11th November 2023 to commemorate birth anniversary of the first Education Minister of Independence India Abul Kalam Azad. The program was organised at the Council Hall of Tezpur University on 11th November 2023 at 10 AM. At the event, faculty members, research scholars, students from various departments were actively participated. Prior to the celebration day, few competitions like Essay Writing & Poster Making were conducted on 9th & 10th November 2023 respectively.
