1. The examination shall be conducted with **online mode** of 2 hours of duration via G-suit Id.
2. The exam will be of 40 marks wherein the students are expected to write three long answer (critical/analytical) of 10 marks each and two short answer of 5 marks each out of the options provided. Course teacher may choose multiple choice or quiz etc.
3. Students who failed/faced problem to download question paper must communicate to their course teacher via email/mobile/WhatsApp and get the matter resolved before start of answer writing time on the day of examination itself otherwise the concern student has to appear again on a date announced by the course teacher.
4. Those students who failed to upload their Answer Script within shall be given another chance and different date shall be announced to conduct exam with different set of questions paper.
5. Once the question paper is downloaded within the time limit specified in the time table, the student has to express his/her intention to appear in examination by sending a confirmation mail or message stating that "the question

paper is downloaded and I am ready to appear for examination of concerned course". This message will be marked as attendance for writing that schedule examination.

6. Each student must write by using black/blue pen and may use any blank page with ruling or without ruling.
