Evaluation of the course MI 517 / MS 517 (Project)

The grading for the course MI 517 / MS 517 (Project) will be done as follows:

The supervisor will have 50% weightage in evaluation and the rest 50% will be evaluated by a 3-member committee not consisting of the supervisor.

A. The supervisor's evaluation will be done on the basis of the following points:

1. Regularity – 10 Marks (A log book may be maintained)
2. Continuous Progress – 10 Marks
3. Writing skill – 10 Marks
4. Overall understanding of subject – 20 Marks

B. The 3-member committee will evaluate on the basis of the following points:

1. Dissertation – 20 Marks
2. Presentation – 10 Marks
3. Individual contribution in the overall work – 5 Marks
4. Interaction – 15 Marks

Each of the committee member will submit their individual scoresheet and the average of them will be considered as the final marks.

Guidelines for the students

All the students registered for the course MI 517 / MS 517 (Project) will have to submit (to the supervisor and possibly to the 3-member committee also) a progress report at the time of the mid term exam. The final project report (Dissertation) (3 copies) has to be submitted by all the students to their respective 3-member committee before commencement of the end term exam and the final presentation will take place immediately after the end term exam. All students will have to submit the final project report and appear in the final presentation. The evaluation team will decide whether a student require extension or not.
