Dr. Nirmal Kumar Saha, did his MTech in Energy Technology (2001) from Tezpur University and PhD from The Energy and Resources Institute, (TERI), New Delhi. He joined CSIR-Central Salt and Marine Chemicals Research Institute, Bhavnagar, as a Research Associate in the Membrane Science and Separation Technology Division in 2008. Presently he is a Senior Scientist in the same division. His research area is focused on pressure-driven polymeric membranes and especially reverse osmosis membrane development for brackish water and seawater desalination. Dr. Saha played a lead role in the development of indigenous brackish water membrane which is commercially successful. He is presently working on seawater desalination membrane development and also keeps a kin interest in membrane biofouling studies and remediation.
