The Ministry of Education (erstwhile, Ministry of Human Resource Development) launched the Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMNMTT) in 2014 and one of its major component Teaching Learning Centre (TLC)s have been engaged in facilitating teacher training throughout the country. It is envisioned that the TLCs will accelerate the teaching-learning process by encouraging independent critical and creative thinking and facilitating research for subject specific growth. The TLCs will assist the faculty in capacity building for curriculum designing, scientific assessment and evaluation and the development of innovative academic programs to strengthen the inclusive nature of higher education. The Teaching Learning Centre, Tezpur University, Assam was set up in 2016 and since its inception it is engaged in assisting capacity building of the teachers for development of innovative skills in teaching, curriculum design, assessment and evaluation techniques and the Centre is specifically encouraged to reach out to teachers teaching in regionally disadvantaged locations of Assam and the North East India. The Centre offers month long Faculty Induction Programs, Refresher Courses, Short Term Courses like Faculty Development Programs in different disciplines, ICT tools in Teaching, Assessment and Evaluation and Action Research Programs. Since April 2020, TLC, Tezpur University has been conducting its programs in online mode following PMMNMTT Guidelines and UGC Regulations.

Teaching Learning Centre, Tezpur University is going to conduct an **Online Weeklong Faculty Development Programme on New Trends in English Studies** during **January 17-21, 2022**.

The FDP is an effort towards empowering teachers with new trends and cross-disciplinary exchange of ideas in English studies for their own professional development. Incorporating ideas from outside the traditional boundary of the disciplines, even the intradisciplinary relations in English studies between English literature, English Language Teaching, and English linguistics have started to assume fresh dimensions in the academia. The main objective of the FDP is to exchange ideas in new areas in English studies like Film, literature, and visual media, Twenty-first-century literature, Form and transformation from novels to blogs, Electronic literature, Positive psychology in English Language Teaching, Future of the English language in a globalized world, Access to Information Technology in English Language Teaching, Cognitive linguistics and Neuroscience and second language learning.

Renowned experts in these fields from India and abroad will take part in the academic discussions of the FDP.

The FDP will include both live sessions and pre-recorded video sessions disseminated in online mode. The entire program will be managed through Google Classroom and Google Meet.

The FDP is open to Faculty members (regular/ad-hoc/temporary) from any Indian university/college and research scholars.

Registration is mandatory for all the participants of the programme. Interested faculty members and research scholars are required to register online on or before January 10, 2022 by paying an enrollment fee of INR 800/- (Non-Refundable).
