Teaching Learning Centre (TLC), Tezpur University in Collaboration with Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development, Sriperumbudur, Tamil Nadu is organizing an Off-line three day Capacity Building Programme on Development of Youths of North Eastern Region for the Research Scholars and Young Faculty Members of North-East India during 09-11 March, 2022. The program is sponsored by Rajiv Gandhi National Institute of Youth Development, Sriperumbudur (RGNIYD).

Concept Note:

Youth development is a process that prepares a young person to meet the challenges of adolescence and adulthood and achieve his or her full potential. Youth development is promoted through activities and experiences that help youth develop social, ethical, emotional, physical, and cognitive competencies. The different capacity building programmes for the youths can have an incredible impact on their communities as they support students, increase access to opportunity, and remove barriers to education and achievement. Youth empowerment is achieved through participation in youth empowerment programs. While the youth of the mainland get adequate opportunities for recovery, participation and development in various spheres, the youth in the North-Eastern Region of our country have limited access to such efforts, therefore they deserve special attention to resurge in the present scenario. The present programme exclusively focuses on the capacity building of the youth through various skill development opportunities.

Rational behind the programme:

The impacts of the pandemic Covid-19 on youth are severe in developed, emerging and developing countries. Economies with high rates of informal employment are particularly vulnerable to shocks. The lockdowns and the spread of the virus mean millions of young people lack social protection, income benefit in case of sickness, and are at risk through inadequate access to universal health care. Even though all economic sectors are affected by the pandemic,

labour-intensive sectors with millions of low-paid and low-skilled young workers have been most dramatically affected.

The programme is designed to raise dialogues and discussions among the youth of north east on the issues and concerns that impinge their development, hence to raise these issues will be the rational of the programme.

Mode of Conduct:

The program will be conducted in physical mode at Teaching Learning Centre, Tezpur University. Selected participants will have to attend all sessions. The sessions will be from 10:00 AM to 4:30 PM everyday with appropriate breaks. Tea and Lunch will be provided to all participants. There is no provision for accommodation. Subject to receipt of fund from RGNIYD, daily allowance at the rate of Rs.500 only may be provided to the participants who successfully complete the program.

Who can Apply: Teachers, research scholars and P.G. students. However, preference will be given to young teachers and research scholars. P.G. students may be selected subject to availability of seats.

Note: Applicants shall upload valid ID proof during registration. Employees/research scholars etc, if selected, shall have to submit a No Objection Certificate/Permission Letter at TLC Office when joining the program. Hence, they are advised to consult their concerned authorities (Employer/HoD/ Supervisor etc.) before applying for registration.

Number of Participants: Total number of seats is 50. Applicants will be selected on first-cum-first serve basis. The students belonging to SC/ST or North-East from neighborhood colleges may also be included to the maximum extent possible.

Pre-Registration:

Pre-Registration is mandatory for all the participants of the workshop. There is no registration fee. Participants need to fill in the following online application form with all necessary details.
