Online Weeklong FDP on ICT Tools for Effective Teaching and Learning (14-18 March, 2022)

Organized by Teaching Learning Centre Tezpur University (A Centre of Excellence in Pedagogy and Curriculum) (Established in 2016 under PMMMNMTT Scheme, Ministry of Education)

Teaching Learning Centre (TLC), Tezpur University is organizing an **Online Weeklong FDP on ICT Tools for Effective Teaching and Learning** during 14-18 March, 2022. The workshop is being organized by TLC, Tezpur University set up under PMMMNMTT Scheme, Ministry of Education, Govt. of India. Teaching Learning Centre, Tezpur University has been conducting Refresher Courses, Faculty Induction Programs and other training Programs including various ICT training programmes for teachers of higher education as per PMMMNMTT mandate since 2016. Since April 2020 TLC, Tezpur University has been conducting all training programs in Online mode following the UGC and PMMMNMTT Guideline. All short term and long term teacher training programs conducted by PMMMNMTT components are considered for Career Advancement Scheme (CAS) for teachers of higher education as per UGC Regulation 2018.

Online educational methodology, and flipped-classrooms with associated pedagogy of active learning, have quickly emerged as the mainstay of effective education in this century. Blended learning has achieved great impact thanks to the interaction between teachers and students, generating positive results in the teaching and learning process. The methodological aspects used with blended learning based on the use of ICT to develop both online and virtual activities allow the participant to develop cognitive, competitive, critical and constructive thinking skills for problem solving. The UGC has already recommended for a Blended Mode of learning where up to 40% teaching can be done in Online mode. Thus, the knowledge of ICT tools useful for higher education and the training for the effective use of such tools are necessary for all. Main objective of this FDP is to create skills and competencies for proper and effective use of ICT in education.

The FDP will include both live sessions and pre-recorded video sessions disseminated in online mode. For convenience of the participant-teachers, the live sessions will be conducted in the afternoon between 2:30 PM and 4:30 PM. There will be maximum 7 live sessions including Inaugural, Valedictory and Interactive sessions. The details will be shared after registration process is complete. Joining the live session is desirable, as it will facilitate live interaction. However, if someone is not able to join the live session, he/she shall watch the recording of the same later.

Course Content:

- Online/blended Learning in teaching-learning
- Google Classroom and MOODLE as Learning Management Systems
- Content management, class organization, assessment in MOOC.
- E-content generation, storage and dissemination
- Online Teaching Learning tools
- Online assessment tools

Course plan:

- There will be approximately 35 hours of engagement including live sessions, recorded sessions, practice sessions, assignments, quiz and feedback.
- Pre-recorded demonstration videos on each tool will be shared in the Google Classroom in scheduled manner.
- Read and watch as per participant's convenience.
- Interaction and discussion through Google classroom and WhatsApp/Telegram group every day.
- Proper balance of activity and assignments.
- Online Feedback on each session.
- Follow-up session for discussing ICT practicing issues.

Who can apply:

The workshop is open to teachers (regular/ad-hoc/temporary) and research scholars from any Indian university/college/institutes. NOC or Leave is not required for enrolling in the programme.

Certification criteria:

- Attempting and submitting all the quizzes and assignments are mandatory, and each participant should score a minimum of 50% in total to avail of the programme completion certificate.
- Completion certificates on the basis of performance will be awarded to the participants.
- As part of the Ministry of Education's requirement under the PMMMNMTT scheme, all participants need to submit online feedback for each session.
- Failing to meet any of the above conditions will result in denial of a certificate of completion to the participants.

Registration:

Registration is mandatory for all the participants of the workshop. Interested participants are required to register online on or before 10 March, 2022 by paying an enrollment fee of INR 800/- (Non-Refundable).
