## AdaptNET Tezpur University

Strengthen education, research, and innovation for climate smart crops in India

## Invitation

AdaptNet (https://adaptnet.aua.gr/) is a capacity building project supported by EACEA (Education, Audiovisual and Culture Executive Agency), European Commission under Erasmus<sup>+</sup> initiative to strengthen education, research, and innovation for climate smart crops in India. AdaptNet consortium consisting of (1) Agricultural University of Athens, Greece; (2) Universita Degli Studi Di Milano, Italy; (3) Academy of Athens, Greece; (4) Universita Politecnica Delle Marche, Italy; (5) Assam Agricultural University, Assam; (6) Tezpur University, Assam; (7) International Crops Research Institute for the Semi-Arid Tropics, Andhra Pradesh and (8) University of Agricultural Sciences, Karnataka. The project is to create a network of highly skilled trainers in India on topics related to climate change impact and management in Agriculture. AdaptNET has recently trained 29 Indian faculty and scientists in European Institutions, including four faculty from Tezpur University, for diffusion of knowledge and skill related to climate change mitigation and outreach to Indian economy and society. As per the mandate of AdaptNET, Tezpur University has floated a new CBCS course "Climate change mitigation and energy management for crop-based livelihood" from the current semester. E-labs are established in each of the Indian Universities, including Tezpur University, as a means for remote training in the areas of climate change mitigation for crop production. Further, Indian PhD students have been selected (four from Tezpur University) to spend two months in European partner laboratories so that they will serve as knowledge ambassadors (in the areas of Climate Change) once back in their Country.
