

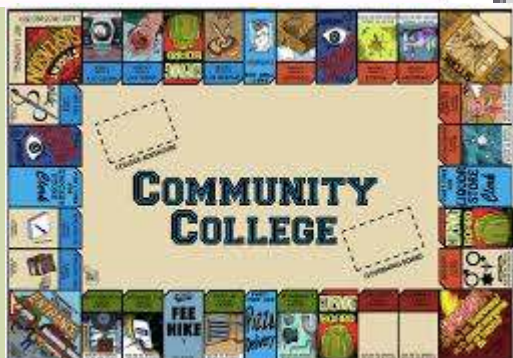

About Tezpur University

Tezpur University was established on January 21, 1994 as per the Tezpur University Act, 1993 enacted by the Parliament. Currently, the University offers 63 carefully chosen academic programmes through 19 departments under the Schools of Engineering, Humanities & Social Sciences, Management, and Sciences. The University also offers 11 programmes under its open and distance mode. With 3300 students, 240 faculty members and 270 administrative and technical personnel, the University today is a hub of quality activities in higher education and research.

The 262-acre sprawling campus of the University sits amidst serene surroundings at Napaam, about 15 km east of Tezpur town in the Sonitpur District of Assam. The campus which has been planned to facilitate latest technologies to flourish with the warmth of the Nature, provides for a perfect ambience for pursuit of education and research.

About Community College

The demand – supply mismatch of skilled manpower and low(19%) Gross Enrolment Ratio (GER) in Indian higher education call for reforms in higher education. Keeping this in mind, the XII plan document on Higher Education has recommended for establishment of 200 community colleges under University Grants Commission (UGC) in the existing colleges/ universities with separate entity. AICTE is also another agency involved in community college schemes in the technical institutions of Higher Education.

The basic objective of Community college scheme of UGC and AICTE is to look for development of communities on the basis of their strength and to bridge the gaps between market demand and supply of skilled workforce so that the economic growth of the country is maintained. These community colleges are to be designed in such a way that these will not create another pool of educated unemployed youths; but will make learners fit to be workforce for various workplaces. The workshop aims to enlighten the participants on the way of establishment and structure of Community College, courses to be offered in these colleges and linkages with work fields.

Objective of the Workshop

1. To enlighten on various models of community colleges
2. To help the participants to enlighten about how to prepare a proposal for establishment of community college either as a separate entity in an existing college/university or in a polytechnic or a new and independent community college
3. To explain various aspects of UGC/AICTE Schemes of Community College, on establishment of UGC/AICTE model Community College/Polytechnic
4. To learn on the variety of subject/trades that a community college can offer looking in to job market
