Pandit Deendayal Upadhyay was a profound philosopher, outstanding organizer and political leader of highest personal integrity. He put forward a complete set of policies and programmes that India should follow to progress. His biggest contribution to the field of philosophy was the ideology of 'Ekatma' or 'integral humanism'. The ideal human being, according to his philosophy would think beyond himself and his family and consider the common good of humanity at large. The ideology was a result of his efforts to build a social, economic and

political structure in India based on the nation's indigenous value systems and its cultural and spiritual heritage. Pt. Upadhyaya believed that India cannot progress unless it stopped following western philosophies of capitalist individualism and communist socialism. Even while accepting modernity, he was of the opinion that modern systems would have to be adapted to core Indian values.
