

About the programme

Bioethics is concerned with the ethical and philosophical implications in scientific research. It encompasses the basic ethical principles of respect for persons beneficence, and justice. In October 2017, The Indian Council of Medical Research issued the National Ethical Guidelines for Biomedical and Health Research Involving Human Participants. The purpose of the guidelines is to safeguard the dignity, rights, safety and well-being of the human participants involved in biomedical and health research. The general principles of the guidelines states that protection of research participants and/or communities should be built into the design of the study, and the four basic principles; namely autonomy, beneficence, non-maleficence and justice must guide the research to protect the dignity, rights, safety and well-being of the research participants. For this, knowledge of Biosafety and Bio-Medical waste management is also important for students and researchers dealing with biologicals wastes, hazardous chemicals and biological samples. This seminar will focus on creating awareness and understanding of these guidelines and will provide an insight into the Bioethics and Biosafety aspects involved in research.
