The University Grant Commission of India has set up the Consortium for Academic and Research Ethics (CARE) to continuously monitor and identify quality journals across all disciplines. This is an effort to distinguish between standard and predatory/dubious/deceptive journals and ensure that Indian academic work appears only in standard journals. To disseminate the UGC CARE's initiatives in the Eastern zone, UGC in collaboration with Tezpur University (the Nodal Center for Eastern India) is organizing a **Research Integrity Awareness Workshop at Tezpur University on 26th August, 2019**. The UGC CARE East zone covers the states of Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Sikkim, Tripura, and West Bengal.

Eminent academicians, administrators and UGC CARE programme coordinators will speak on research and publication integrity, the UGC CARE programme and reconfiguration of the UGC journal list. This will be followed by a panel discussion and interactive session that will provide an opportunity to personally interact with a cross section of stakeholders.

We invite all members of the academic fraternity to participate in the workshop, be informed and address their concerns on publication in UGC CARE approved journals.
