The "<u>Indian Nanoelectronics Users' Program" (INUP)</u> which is funded by the Dept of Electronics and Information Technology (DeitY), the Ministry of Communication and Information Technology (MCIT), Govt. of India, announces a "2 Day Familiarization Workshop on Nanofabrication Technologies" jointly with Tezpur University held during April 25-26, 2015.

The DeitY has supported the establishment of Centres of Excellence in Nanoelectronics at IIT Bombay and IISc Bangalore. The INUP was initiated in 2008 to extend these facilities for research and process/product development to researchers from other academic Institutions and R&D laboratories. INUP has successfully completed five years of operation and has entered its "Second Phase". It provides financial support (fabrication/characterization cost, travel and stay) to the researchers from academia for the execution of their work at these centres. INUP organizes Familiarization Workshops periodically at both the centres to provide awareness of different aspects of the field of Nanoelectronics and exposure to the range of facilities available at the centres. The overwhelming response from the participants has encouraged us to organize workshops in remote parts of the country. It will involve experts from IISc and IITB travelling to these locations, as well as experts from nearby institutions. This workshop is being organized both for familiarization as well as for interaction of the participants with faculty members. It would provide the overview of research activities and the facilities available at IITBNF and procedure to avail these facilities under INUP.

Online applications are invited from interested researchers from academia and R&D laboratories for the participation in this workshop. While selecting the participants, preferences will be given to faculty members and Ph. D students of academic institutions from nearby states (Arunchal Pradesh, Sikkim, Meghalaya, Nagaland, Manipur, Tripura and Mizoram).

There is no registration fee and limited accommodation will be provided on request from participants, subject to availability. Local hospitality will be taken care of by INUP.
