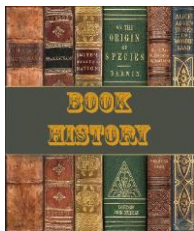


NATIONAL SEMINAR ON BOOK HISTORY IN NORTH-EAST INDIA
