

Online Basic Training on Use of ICT in Teaching

In view of the current crisis related to COVID19 and in line with the spirit of the PMMMNMTT Scheme of MHRD, Government of India Teaching Learning Centre, Tezpur University organized a Two Day Online Basic Training on Use of ICT in Teaching for teachers of higher education on 20 and 23 April, 2020. The objective of the program was to enable the teachers to use household ICT tools for creation and dissemination of e-resources and management of online class. The workshop level was basic and was beneficial for the new users.

The programme was in the form of pre-recorded delivery of e contents through streaming application. Sessions on *Use of Digital Learning Platforms in Education, Use of Google Classroom: Tutorial for Teachers, Screencasting for E-learning, Tutorials on screencast-o-matic and Free cam, Live Classes Using Free Tools*, and preparation of *Open Educational Resources and Database* were successfully conducted. Six sessions were conducted by in-house members of TLC, TU, while one resource person was from within Tezpur University.

About 950 teachers from institutions of higher education registered for the programme from all over the country, almost 40% being from outside the state of Assam. More than 70 teachers from Tezpur University were also benefitted from the programme. Participants needed to generate modules themselves as part of the tasks assigned. Assignments are being evaluated, and individual feedback, wherever necessary shall be made available to them. The programme was well appreciated by the participants and covered in local media also.

Teaching Learning Centre, Tezpur University plans to conduct more such programmes in future.

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
