# About the workshop

The aim of this workshop is to initiate a brainstorming exercise for devising the strategies to promote cultivation and value addition of high value medicinal and aromatic plants (MAPs) ingredients that can help to alleviate income of small and marginal farmers through harnessing available waste-land of Arunachal Pradesh in an environmental friendly manner. The value added products will build a complete ecosystem in a cluster of villages from cultivation, to distillation of essential oils followed by producing value-added products. Arunachal Pradesh has the potential to enhance the income of farmers by promotion of location specific MAPs by use of appropriate scientific interventions suitable for diverse agro-climatic regions that ranged from tropical, sub-tropical, temperate and alpine regions. Strategic utilization of under-utilized fertile land for propagation of MAPs can help to contribute in enhancing the number of self-employed entrepreneurs, employment generation and eventually building demand of essential oils for sustainable cultivation of aromatic crops.

In this programme, scientist, farmers, enterpreneurs and unemployed youths are expected to participate and interact regarding future prospect of aromatic crops and their potential for boosting rural economy. The experts will deliver lectures on the national and international status of essential oils and their economic significance. Discussions will be held to find ways that can support the farmers/entrepreneurs to develop farmer's producer organization (FPO) and technical know-how support from CSIR-IIIM Jammu, CSIR-IHBT Palampur, CSIR-CIMAP Lucknow and Tezpur University.
