Activities

- Tezpur University's foreign students participated in the one-day conclave "ADVANTAGE ASSAM" dated: 26/02/2025 organized by Govt. of Assam, Guwahati.
- On December 13, 2024 the Directorate of International Affairs (DIA) organized a get together function to welcome newly joined foreign students-2024 of the university. The function was attended by the Vice-Chancellor, Dean, Academic Affairs, Dean, School of Sciences, Dean, School of Management, and the Registrar.
- A special convocation is organized in the VC board room on 01/07/2024, for nine pass out international students of different Programmes (UG, PG and PhD) in the year 2024.
- A special convocation is organized in the VC board room on 12/07/2023, for seven pass out international students of different Programmes (PG and PhD) in the year 2023.
- A special convocation is organized in the VC board room on 06/07/2022, for three pass out international students of different Programmes (UG, PG and PhD) in the year 2022.
- 72nd Foundation Day of Indian Council for External Affairs (ICCR), Ministry of External Affairs is organized by Tezpur University from 9th-10th April, 2022.
- On December 8, 2021 the International Students' Office (ISO) organized a function to welcome new foreign students to the university. The function was attended by the Vice-Chancellor, Dean, Academic Affairs, Dean, School of Sciences, Dean, School of Management, and the Registrar.
- The ISO organized a function to give away certificates to final year foreign students on August 9, 2021. The VC, PVC, Dean, Academic Affairs, Registrar, and Controller of Examinations gave away the certificates.
- International students were vaccinated against Covishield-19 on June 22, 2021 in the Health Centre.
- Tezpur University's foreign students participated in the two-day conclave (April 9-10, 2021) organized by ICCR at Dibrugarh University on the occasion of ICCR's foundation day.
- On November 20, 2020 the International Students' Office organized a meeting of an ICCR delegation with the twenty-eight foreign students on the campus. The delegation, led by

Ms. Madhurkankana Roy, Director, ICCR Guwahati expressed its satisfaction with the arrangements and facilities provided to the students.

- Because of Covid-19 the university declared a lockdown from March 18, 2020 onwards. All university students were required to vacate the hostels but foreign students were exempted from this requirement. The International Students' Office coordinated with university authorities to ensure the welfare of the foreign students (including delivery of essentials to their hostel rooms and reaching out to their parents in their home countries).
- On February 18, 2019 the International Students' Office organized a meeting of the Regional Director of the Indian Council for Cultural Relations (ICCR) with the ICCR-sponsored foreign students of the university. Matters relating to the welfare of the students were discussed in the meeting.
- The Director (and four Deans) visited National Chung Hsing University, Taichung, Taiwan on December 17 and 18, 2018 to discuss collaboration with Tezpur University. This visit was partly financed by National Chung Hsing University.
- On September 28, 2018 the ISO organized (at Tezpur University) an interaction of ICCR students with the Regional Director, Guwahati.
- On August 9, 2018 the ISO organized a meeting of foreign students with the Vice Chancellor.
- A get-together of graduating foreign students was held on June 23, 2018.
- A MoU was signed with National Chung Hsing University, Taiwan on February 22, 2018.
- On January 19, 2017 the International Students' Office organized a meeting in the VC's office room with a Japanese delegation consisting of Mr. Yukio Takeyari, Chair, NASSCOM, Japan Council and former head of Sony India, and Mr. Takafumi Nishi, CEO, Matsubaya. The delegation was visiting Assam on Amtron's initiative to promote student exchange and placements in Japanese companies.
- On February 7, 2016 the International Students' Office organized two back-to-back information seminars (regarding Fulbright and other fellowships) for faculty and students, conducted by Sudarshan Das and Sumanta Basu of United States-India Educational Foundation, Kolkata.
- The International Students' Office organized a meeting of a visiting team from Begum Royeka University, Rangpur, Bangladesh with faculty of the Department of Business Administration on May 23, 2016. The possibility of academic collaboration was discussed.
