TU Team brings Laurels to the State

In yet another recognition to Tezpur University, its students have bagged six national prizes in the 32nd All India Inter University National Youth Festival (Shivotsav), 2017 organized by Association of Indian Universities (AIU) in the Shivaji University, Maharashtra during 10-14 February 2017. The event is sponsored by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports, Government of India. Out of the six prizes won by the University, one is Gold (Classical Vocal), four Silvers (*light vocal, quiz, folk orchestra, and classical dance*) and a fourth position (western group song). Sri Anurag Baruah, M.Sc (final semester) from the department of Mathematical Sciences of the University has fetched the Gold. Prior to this, they were selected for the nationals in 7 various events from the East Zone Youth Festival held at Vidyasagar University, West Bengal.



A total of 82 universities were selected from the zonal events at different zones and participated in the national youth festival which is conducted annually in different universities of the country. This year, *University of Mumbai* is declared as the national champion of the mega event. The 31-member team of Tezpur University was led by Mr. Barnam Jyoti Saharia, Asstt. Professor, Dept. of Electrical Engineering and the Cultural Officer Ms. Bhupali Kashyap of the University.

It is pertinent to mention that Tezpur University is invited to participate in the *South Asian University's Festival* on the **light vocal event** to be performed by Sri Anurag Baruah which is scheduled during 28 February – 04 March 2017 at Devi Ahilya Viswavidyalaya, Indore.
