Prof. Ashis K. Mukherjee Received Prestigious Award from Indian Academy of Biomedical Sciences, Lucknow



In recognition to outstanding research contribution in the field of Biomedical Sciences (basic research), the Indian Academy of Biomedical Sciences, Lucknow honored Prof. Ashis K. Further, Prof. Mukherjee has also been elected as a Fellow of the Royal Society of Biology (FRSB), UK.
