Prof. Kumar has published around 160 research papers in peer reviewed international journals and has successfully guided 18 doctoral students. He is a recipient of commonwealth Academic Fellowship, UK in 2014. A former Dean of the School of Sciences, he has been a faculty member of the department of Physics since 1999.
