TU faculty elected as Council Member of the prestigious International Union of Immunological Societies (IUIS)

In yet another recognition to Tezpur University, Prof. Shashi Baruah of Dept. of Molecular Biology & Biotechnology has been elected to the Council Member of the prestigious International Union of Immunological Societies (IUIS). The election of the 2019-2022 Council of IUIS was held at meeting of General Assembly of IUIS during the 17th International Congress of Immunology (IUIS 2019) held at Beijing, China.

The International Union of Immunological Societies (IUIS) is an umbrella organization for many of the regional and national societies of immunology throughout the world. There are currently 83 Member Societies of IUIS, many of which belong to one of 4 Regional Federations encompassing Europe, Latin America, Africa and Asia-Oceania or are direct members such as US and Canada. That represents more than 60 000 immunologists all over the world. Links with other international scientific bodies are promoted through the International Affiliate Members of IUIS, membership of the International Council for Science (ICS) and formal liaison with the World Health Organization (WHO).

As the Council Member, Dr. Baruah will be focusing on the areas of gender issues and advancement of Immunology teaching and research in developing countries. Currently Dr. Baruah is serving as the Vice President (East) for Indian Immunology Society (IIS).
