

CDAC to create *High Performance Computing Infrastructure* at TU

The Centre for Development of Advanced Computing (CDAC) under the Ministry of Communication and Information Technology, Government of India has approved the project proposal titled “Establishment of State-of-the-art High Performance Computing Infrastructure for Scientific Computing in the North - East at Department of CSE, Tezpur University”. The duration of the project is 24 months (2015 – 17) while the total financial outlay for the project is ₹ 122.50 Lakh. Shri Ashish Ranjan of CDAC, Pune and Prof D K Bhattacharyya of CSE Department will act as the Principal Investigators of the project.
