

CBMR-NMRS Gold Medal

The Centre for Bio-medical Magnetic Resonance (CBMR), Lucknow in collaboration with the National Magnetic Resonance Society, India (NMRS) has instituted a Gold Medal to encourage young scientists, working in India in the area of magnetic resonance and its applications.

The age limit for consideration for the award is 35 years, as on 31st December 2013.

Self nominations are invited from the competing scientists. Please send, your complete CV, list of publication with their impact factors, copies of published papers to Prof. C.L. Khetrpal, CBMR, Sanjay Gandhi Post Graduate Institute of Medical Sciences Campus, by e-mail (clkhetrapal@hotmail.com). If the file sizes are big, please send the zipped file as an attachment.

Nominations will be accepted till 10th January, 2014.

The awardee will be chosen based on the nominee's academic achievements. All the papers published by the nominee in a calendar year, i.e. from **1-1-2013 to 31-12-2013** will be considered. The papers should have full citation, such as, Journal Name, Year, Volume and Page numbers. Any other format, such as, manuscript accepted, manuscript submitted, manuscript under preparation, manuscript under review, manuscript in press, etc. will not be considered.

The criterion for selection is purely on the basis of Impact Factor and the number of authors in each publication. As an example, if a nominee is one of the 3 authors of a paper published in a Journal with an impact factor of 6.2, then he/she earns $6.2/3$ points (= 2.067 points).

The points from each paper of the nominee will be calculated in the said manner. The nominee who earns the maximum number of points, which is the cumulative additive value from all his / her published papers, will be chosen for the award.

The result of the Award will be declared before **15th January, 2014**. The awardee will be invited to present the work in NMRS-2014.
