## NMRS Prof. S. Subramanian's 60<sup>th</sup> Birthday Lecture Award

NMRS invites nominations for Prof. S. Subramanian's 60<sup>th</sup> Birthday Lecture Award. The award is given annualy to an outstanding scientist working in any area of magnetic resonance. The award has been instituted from an endowment received from his students and colleagues to honour Prof.S.Subramanian, former Professor of Chemistry at IIT, Chennai. The work done in India by a nominee will be recognized for the award. However, outstanding work, primarily done by the nominee during short visits abroad could also be included for the consideration of the committee and an integrated view will be taken.

## The age limit is 45 years as on 31<sup>st</sup> December, 2013.

Any life-member of NMRS can nominate a scientist who should also be a life-member of NMRS. Self-nominations are also accepted. Nominations are valid for three consecutive years (subject to the age-restriction). The nominees for the years 2011 and 2012 may update their CV and list of publications.

Nominations should contain, latest CV, list of publications, a one page write-up of major scientific contributions in the last five years, copies of 5 important papers published in the last 5 years, by email to both the president (vcgndu@gmail.com) and secretary of NMRS (nsp@sif.iisc.ernet.in).

If self-nominated, please provide a list of three references, one of which must be an NMRS life-member.

The award consists of a cash prize of Rs.10000/- (Rupees ten thousand only), a citation and a certificate, and will be presented in NMRS-2014, to be held at Tezpur University, Tezpur during Feb, 2-5, 2014. The awardee has to make an oral presentation of the work that lead to the award. The award does not cover the travel expenses for attending NMRS-2014.

The winner of the Award will be announced during first week of January 2014.
