- ✓ Layout of submission :
 - Top page
 - Topic / Theme (exactly as provided above)
 - Author's name, enrolment no, hostel, contact details
 - Next page onwards
 - Body content of the essay, including references, explanatory note/s (with absolutely no indication of author's name, department or any other identifier). References, if any, are to be placed at end of essay on fresh page, in **APA style**
- ✓ Three copies of the print, **along with plagiarism check report**, (in one single sealed envelope, on A4 paper, Times New Roman of font size 11, with 1.5 line gap) is to be deposited at Office of the Department of Business Administration latest by Thursday, the **31st of January 2019, 5PM**.
