Notification

In view of the rising COVID- 19 cases in the country and as advised by the Chief Secretary, Government of Assam vide letter no ASDMA.24/2020/Part-1/153, following steps are taken to contain the spread of COVID-19 on the Tezpur University campus:

1. Self-isolate by staying at home/hostel if you begin to feel unwell or feel symptoms of COVID-19. One should immediately undergo COVID-19 tests or intimate the same to Warden/DSW/University administration, as the case may be.
2. Maintain proper social distancing and hygiene on the campus all the time.
3. Avoid unnecessary gathering.
4. All the students are advised to stay at the campus and avoid unnecessary gathering. All members of TU community are requested to continue academic activities and essential work with proper COVID- 19 precautions.
5. All wardens of hostels are requested to remain vigilant to handle COVID-19 related cases. The notification issued by Dean Students' Welfare vide Memo No. TU/DSW/notice/16-F.08/1074-A dated 31-03-2021 be strictly followed.
6. Wearing of mask is mandatory on the campus.
7. Students are advised not to venture out of the campus unnecessarily for their own safety.
8. Booking of Community Hall/Council Hall/KBR Auditorium etc. for organizing any event will depend on the advisories issued by the Govt. of India and Govt. of Assam guidelines.
9. Executive Engineer shall monitor the movement of workers of construction activities and compliance of COVID-19 protocols.

10. Owners of commercial shops/eateries located on the campus will ensure they maintain COVID-19 protocols. In case, any workers are suffering from COVID-19 like symptoms, they will bring it to the notice of the University administration immediately.

11. The situation will be reviewed periodically and further decision will be taken accordingly. The Competent Authority of the University urges all to remain vigilant to handle the present COVID- 19 pandemic situation. All are requested to observe the guidelines, SOPs issued by the Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, Ministry of Aayush etc. from time to time to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
