## NOTIFICATION

Dated:25.02.2021

As per batch wise campus plan for Spring Semester 2021 of the University to call back students to the University hostels after COVID-19 pandemic situation, 6th semester students of Int. M Sc. & B Sc./B.Ed programme under the School of Sciences and 6th semester students of Int. M Com programme under the School of Management Sciences of Tezpur University are being allowed to return to hostels within 01.03.2021 to 05.03.2021 as per the list attached herewith, provided they are neither infected by COVID -19 nor undergoing any COVID-19 treatment.. They will be allowed to carry out their academic activities within the period of 1.03.2021 to 11.04.2021. Students will be accommodated in single room accommodation in the University Hostels as per UGC guidelines (notification no. D.O. 14-8/2020 CPP-II, dtd 5th November 2020, clause 3.2 ). They need to undergo 14 days quarantine after entering the hostels and must follow Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) for hostels (as notified in the hostel notice board) during their stay.

They need to take fresh hostel admission along with payment of other dues as per University Rules. They must submit an undertaking to the Hostel administration as per the format attached herewith at the time of their entry to hostel and abide by the following Standard Operating Procedure (SOP).

- Undergo RAT/ RT-PCR test three days before coming to the hostel. The report of the test must be submitted to hostel administration at the time of entry to the hostel.
- Keep himself/herself quarantined in the allotted room of his/her hostel for 14 days from the date of his/her entry to the hostel room and keep himself/herself be isolated from his/her fellow boarders during this period.
- Undergo Rapid Antigen Test (RAT) after completion of 14 days quarantined period and if test result appears negative then they will be allowed to resume their academic activities.
- Remain alert about himself/herself and fellow boarders with signs and symptoms i.e., fever, cough, body ache and difficulty in breathing. If any such signs appear, they will immediately contact the concerned University Authority for necessary action.
- Download “Aarogya Setu App” in the mobile phone & check regularly
- “Wear Mask, Follow Physical Distancing, Maintain Hand Hygiene”
- Aren't allowed to venture out of the University campus until further notice.
- Maintain proper social distancing and hygiene in the Hostel.
- Avoid any gathering.
- Follow COVID-19 norms notified from time to time by Government of India or by the University
- Liabile for any disciplinary action as per University Rules and Regulations, COVID-19 pandemic norms and Hostel Rules, 2019 in case of violation of the prescribed guidelines.
