Concept Note

Thus Social Sciences in contemporary times has opened up to critical theoretical engagement with contemporary realities of Dalits and Tribals, women and other marginalized groups.

The Orientation Programme, intended for faculty members and research scholars of Social Sciences, would attempt to delve into the complexities and dynamics of the emerging theories of Social science as well as deliberate upon the facets of Social Science Research.
