

2.0 REGULAR ACTIVITIES:

NSS Volunteers undertake various programmes in the adopted villages, college/school campuses and urban slums during weekends or after college hours. Some of the Regular Activities are Plantation Campaign, Blood Donation Campaign, Cleanliness Drives, Survey of the Village/Area, Republic Day Celebrations, Health and Hygiene Awareness Programmes, Anti-Drug Abuse Campaigns, Independence Day Celebrations, etc.

Out of the several regular activities held, some of the noteworthy ones are mentioned below:-

• ENVIRONMENTAL CONSERVATION

Plantation drives: The NSS unit of the institute has organized several Plantation Drives in and around Tezpur University campus. The Programme Coordinator addressed the volunteers about the role of trees in human life. He also mentioned that we should take utmost care of environment. 





NYK organises district youth parliament at Nowgong College

NAGAON, Dec 29: As a part of National Youth Parliament Festival 2021, Nehru Yuva Kendra Nagaon on Monday last organised a district youth parliament at the conference hall of Nowgong College. The programme was through virtual mode where more than 100 participants from seven districts including Nagaon, Hojai, Morigaon, Kamrup Metro, Sonitpur, Biswanath and Lakhimpur have participated. Principal of Nowgong College Dr Sarat Borkataki inaugurated the contest. The main objectives of the youth parliament is to hear the voice of youth between 18 and less than 25 years of age, who are allowed to vote but cannot stand as a candidate for election.

As a jury member Dr Khargeswar Bhuyan, the retired principal of Nowgong College, Pankaj Hazarika, educationist cum social representative of UNO, Randip Nandi, social worker, Sujit Das, noted artist and Guinness world record holder and senior journalist Hareswar Borah were also present. P Chakravarty, district youth officer of Nehru Yuva Kendra, Nagaon; Dr Bhuwan Chutia, NSS nodal officer and Iqbal Choudhury, accountant of NYK Nagaon also highlighted the importance of this youth parliament. Rupam Bora and Gitanjali Borthakur from Nagaon, Anurudh Sahu and Kanchan Chouhan from Hojai, Geetanjali Mali and Niharika Dev Choudhury from Sonitpur, Pawan Upadhyay and Prachurjya Sarmah from Biswanath, Puja Nath and Manju Limbu from Lakhimpur, Rica Bhowmik and Nripen Mandal from Morigaon and Pratik Parmey and Anisha Chakraborty from Kamrup Metro have been selected as the best two contestants from the respective districts. Notably, the top three from a state will be able to contest in the National Youth Parliament at New Delhi next.
