A brief description of activities on United Nations SDG-4 undertaken by Tezpur University

Tezpur University has always taken positive initiatives towards sustainability and inclusion and organised many activities and educational events for the improvement of quality education. The main vision of the University was to develop human excellence and inculcate leadership through hard work and creativity.

1. DISTANCE AND ONLINE EDUCATION-

Tezpur University is offering distance learning programmes and online programmes are under preparation to be launched shortly. The Centre provides free access to Audio Video lectures and quality self-learning materials for all its admitted learners as well as to other interested lifelong learners as well.

2.LIFE LONG LEARNING MEASURE-

Tezpur University provides One Year Diploma and Masters courses programmes as short-term courses for all interested lifelong learners with open to the general public executive education programmes for people who are not attending the university regularly the courses are MA in English, MA in Sociology, MA in Mass Communication and Journalism along with some diploma courses are also provides like Diploma in Child Right and Governance, Diploma in Human Resource Management, etc.

3.ACCESSIBILITY (DIGITAL AND PHYSICAL)-

Tezpur University has been prioritizes the needs of students and staff with disabilities by implementing wheelchair-accessible ramps, elevators, assistive technologies, gender neutral toilet and specialized software to ensure inclusive accessibility facilities. An inclusive curriculum is reflected in efforts to incorporate diverse perspectives, cultures, and voices into our courses, thereby providing a well-rounded educational experience and promoting understanding and empathy among students.

4. OUTREACH ACTIVITIES AND TALENT DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMS-

Our university undertakes educational outreach activities beyond campus, focusing on community engagement and education. We organize talent development programs, community radio initiatives, and counselling sessions for school students in local villages, including Harigaon, Adabari, Jhawani, Napaam, and Amolapam.

As a part of School Internship, students of 2nd year B.Ed. and Integrated B.Sc.B.Ed. Are engaged in different community engagement activities on different social issues and educational issues. They identify different issues from different villages and do awareness campaign and also

participate in celebration and observation of days and events related to Regional and National days and events.

Tezpur university has 1278 graduates students in the year of 2022 and 81 students who gained a qualification that entitled them to teach at primary school level.

5. COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMES-

These initiatives aim to promote education, awareness, and social responsibility, while fostering community development and encouraging student volunteerism. Examples include collaborations with local schools, student-led volunteer schemes like Viksit Bharat @ 2047, and partnerships with community organizations and corporate entities for CSR support.
