## Research income from industry and commerce

Tezpur University has made significant strides in securing research income from industry and commerce, a total amount of ₹10,722,072 which includes:

- ₹7,393,581 from STEM-related research, highlighting the university's strong industry partnerships in science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.
- ₹3,328,491 from Arts, Humanities, and Social Sciences, reflecting the university's diverse research contributions across a wide range of disciplines.

University employs a total of 553 staff members, with 282 academic staff contributing to its diverse educational and research activities. The breakdown of academic staff by subject area is as follows:

- 179 academic staff in STEM disciplines, reflecting the university's strong emphasis on science, technology, engineering, and mathematics.
- 77 academic staff in Arts & Humanities and Social Sciences, showcasing the university's commitment to a broad, interdisciplinary approach to education.
- 26 academic staff from other subject areas of different academic centres, adding further depth to the university's academic offerings across various fields.
