Report

Weeklong Online Workshop on Online Evaluation System (22-26 June 2021)

In association with Nowgong College, Assam

The Teaching Learning Centre, Tezpur University has been conducting different interdisciplnary and discipline specific Faculty Development Programmes along with other training Programs for teachers of higher education as per PMMMNMTT mandate since 2018. Keeping in view the norms regarding COVID19 Pandemic, Teaching Learning Centre, in association with Nowgong College, Nagaon, Assam conducted one weeklong online FDP in Online Evaluation System during 22-26 June 2021.

The areas covered in the FDP are - Online Examination System: Basic Philosophy, Cloud Based Storage of E-content, LMS MOODLE and Evaluation, LMS Google Classroom & Evaluation, Innovative Tools for Online Assessment and Evaluation etc.

The FDP course included both live sessions and pre-recorded video sessions disseminated in online mode and some related activity along with assignments were given to the participants. The entire program was managed through Google Classroom and Google Meet. There were 130 registered participants in the programme and completion certificate was given to 120 eligible participants. Feedback on the sessions were carried out on each day to assess the quality of the programme.

A Standard Operating Procedure(SOP) of the program was shared in online platform. The Google Classroom comment facility and WhatsApp Group was used as

discussion forum for technical sessions in addition to live discussion during live meetings.

Day 1: 22-06-2021 Tuesday

The inaugural cum introduction session of the FDP was graced by the Director of TLC, TU Professor Subhrangshu Sekhar Sarkar, the Principal of Nowgong College, Dr. Sarat Barkotoky, the Deputy Director of TLC, TU Dr. Bipul Kumar Sarma and Dr. Bhuban Chandra Chutia, Coordinator, IQAC, Nowgong College (Autonomous) were also present. The program was coordinated by Dr. Swapna Bora and Ikbal Ahmed, Assistant Professors of TLC, Tezpur University. The objective of the FDP was stated by the Director and rules and regulations of attending classes were explained by the TLC coordinator of the FDP.

The second session was a live panel discussion on the topic: Online Examination System: Basic Philosophy. The panelists were: 1.Dr. Dhruba Jyoti Choudhury, Controller of Examinations, Gauhati University 2. Dr. Ram Shankar, Controller of Examinations, Central University of Odisha, 3. Dr. L Boral, Controller of Examinations, Tezpur University. The panel discussion was moderated by: Prof. S. S. Sarkar, Director, Teaching Learning Centre, Tezpur University. The panelists shared the knowledge on different aspects evaluation system and evaluation norms followed in their respective institutes and how they are preparing for online evaluation system.

In the next session the Resource Person was Ikbal Hussain Ahmed, Assistant Professor, TLC, Tezpur University who took a live session on the topic "Cloud Based Storage and Sharing. After the live discussion, a recoded tutorial was shared in the Google Classroom. The discussion was mainly practical orientation of preparing and sharing e-content. With the help of cloud based storage system we can upload, download or access our data anywhere anytime. We came to know how data gets

stored in remote server and how it is possible to assess without transforming manually. With being present in front of the computer or desktop it's possible to assess data through this cloud storage. The resource person has discussed about the concept of cloud and the different devices which uses this cloud computing to access data. After this session the participants were asked to practice on the software following the recorded tutorial.

At the end of the day, the participants were asked to submit Online Feedback. Here participants could rate different aspects of a resource person's session. Additionally, the participants had to submit summary of their learning in the Feedback.

Day 2: 23-06-2021 Wednesday

The first two sessions were conducted by Dr. Bipul Kumar Sarmah, Deputy Director, TLC,TU on the topic "LMS MOODLE and Evaluation". The session detailed minutely about Moodle platform for organizing classes, managing assignments, quizzes, exams and assessments. The session was clear and explanatory

In the afternoon sessions, the pre-recorded videos on Moodle was shared with participants for hands on practice. The resource person was available online for answering queriries from participants.

At the end of the day, the participants were asked to submit Online Feedback. Here participants could rate different aspects of a resource person's session. Additionally, the participants had to submit summary of their learning in the Feedback

Day 3: 24-06-2021 Thursday

Two live sessions were conducted by Dr. Swapna Bora, Assistant Professor, TLC, TU. The topic was LMS Google for Evaluation. In the First Session she deliverd on Creation of Google Classroom, Adding Participants, Creating Posts, Uploading Materials (File, Links etc.), Creating Assignments (assigning marks, submission deadlines), Grading Submissions etc. In the Second Session she delivered on Creating Google Forms, Different types of Questions, Adding Image/Videos, File Uploads, confirming submission receipts, getting respondents email, retrieving responses etc. In the afternoon sessions some recorded tutorials were shared for the hands-on-practice by participants and the same was coordinated by the resource person.

At the end of the day, the participants were asked to submit Online Feedback. Here participants could rate different aspects of a resource person's session. Additionally, the participants had to submit summary of their learning in the Feedback

Day 4: 25-06-2021 Friday

The first session(live) was delivered by Dr. B. S. Balaji, Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU), New Delhi. Dr. Balaji shared his vast experience on different aspects of Google Classroom. The resource person speaks on the use of different technical means for online teaching and evaluation. Advanced evaluation methods such as Answer Keys, Marking Scheme and Rubrics are discussed elaborately in the session. A rubric is an explicit set of criteria used for assessing a particular type of work and provides more details than a single grade or mark. Typically designed as a grid-type structure, a grading rubric includes criteria, levels of performance, scores, and descriptors which become unique assessment tools for any given assignment. Grading rubrics are effective and efficient tools which allow for objective and consistent assessment of a range of performances, assignments, and activities. Rubrics can help clarify your

expectations and will show students how to meet them, making students accountable for their performance in an easy-to-follow format. The feedback that students receive through a grading rubric can help them improve their performance on revised or subsequent work. Rubrics can help to rationalize grades when students ask about your method of assessment. Rubrics also allow for consistency in grading for those who team teach the same course, for TAs assigned to the task of grading, and serve as good documentation for accreditation purposes. The session ended with discussion with participants.

In the second session a live lecture on "Innovative Tools for Online Assessment and Evaluation" was delivered by Dr. Tejinder Pal Singh, University Business School, Panjab University. The speaker demonstrated the use of different tools like: Quizzes, Google classroom, Mentimeter, Edpuzzle, Socrative, Poll everywhere, Padlet etc. highlighting the key features and how it it can be used for evaluation. The session ended with discussion with participants. In the afternoon sessions, the recording of morning sessions were shared with participants and they instructed to do hands-on-practice. The sessions were monitored by TLC faculties.

At the end of the day, the participants were asked to submit Online Feedback. Here participants could rate different aspects of a resource person's session. Additionally, the participants had to submit summary of their learning in the Feedback.


Day 5: 26-06-2021 Saturday










Links to NMTT Portal:


