Report on

Refresher Course on Teacher Education (Interdisciplinary) September 06 – 20, 2019

(In collaboration with Department of Education)

TLC and Dept., of Education, Tezpur University during September 6 and September 20, 2019 jointly organized an Interdisciplinary Refresher Course on Teacher Education. The program was funded under PMMMNMTT Scheme. Twenty Seven eminent resource persons from different institution shared their knowledge and experience. 44 participants from across the country successfully completed the program. The session wise details are given below.

Day 1: Dated on: 6/09/2019

The inaugural session was started at 9.30 AM by lighting lamp ceremony and welcoming the guest to the dais by the programme Coordinator & Head of the Department of Education Dr. Nil Ratan Roy and Co-Coordinator Dr. Rajinder Singh and felicitated the guest with a Gamosa and a memento. The coordinator of the programme has delivered the welcoming speech and followed by a speech delivered by Dr. D.K. Bhattacharya, Dean of Academic Affairs.

In the morning session, the chief guest Prof. Mihir K. Choudhury delivered an invaluable lecture on Draft National Education Policy, 2019 EQUI (2019-2024), Suggestions on NEP, and Sustainable goals 2030. After tea break the first session of the day resumed a talk on academic and administrative process of the educational institution and the qualities of a good leader by honorable registrar of Tezpur University Dr. Biren Das. The speaker has emphasized on the philosophy influencing the NEP 2019 and discussed about the key aspects of higher education. The next and final session of the day started after one hour of lunch break. The very session was shared by Prof. Prasanta Kr. Das, Department of EFL & Dean School of HSS, Tezpur University. Prof. Das has covered two successive sessions on the topics 'Reading matters', and

'English and higher education in India', respectively.

Day 2: Dated on: 7/09/2019

The 2nd day has started from 9.30 AM. The day has begun with felicitation to the resource person, Dr. Balendra Kr. Das, University of Science and Technology Meghalaya. The resource person has delivered a talk on 'Education and career'. The lecture was comprehensive, informative,

Prof. Sharma began his talk by historicizing the concept of globalization and its subsequent effects on higher education. Prof. Sharma highlighted on 'Liberalism, neo liberalism and its extensive impact', which was followed by the 'Formation of the Neo Liberal Policies and the final crystallization into the World Trade Organization (WTO), NAFTA, and EU etc.' The final session of the day was ended up by 5.30 PM.

Ambedkar University, Lucknow with his talk on 'Constructive pedagogy' which proved to be a very informative, valuable for entire teaching carrier. He shared the session in a very interesting way.
