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Theme of the Workshop

The development of community, society, nation and universe is dependent on educational system. The holistic development of children of any nation is in the hand of teachers. School education has a symbiotic relationship with teacher education as teachers are the frontline providers of quality education.

Sufficient supply of well-qualified and well-trained teachers is the most important, if not the only, contributing factor of school effectiveness and quality of learning. With this paradigm shift from simplistic linear quantitative expansion to qualitative transformation in school education, the teacher education system in the country has increasingly emerged, during the last two decades or more, as an area of overriding concern. If teacher education institutions could be organized to become “dynamic centres of progressive educational movements, the whole task of educational reconstruction would be greatly facilitated.” (NCFTE, 2009). This conviction underscores the importance of the nature of Teacher Education Institutions in our country.

In this respect many commissions and committees were

formed but most the valuable steps were taken for quality control of Teacher Education by the Justice Verma commission. Recommendations of the Verma commission have proved to be crucial.

NCTE released a new regulation on 30 November 2014. The new regulation and revised the curriculum framework for teacher education extended the duration of the programmes of teacher education with the objective of preparing quality teachers and teacher educators.

Quality is always demanded in field of Teacher Education. Under the aegis of the Teaching Learning Centre, the Department of Education, Tezpur University has taken an initiative to play a role in capacity development of teacher educators and school teachers to provide quality Education by organizing a two days’ workshop to provide a common platform for teacher educators and school teachers, and academicians to understand and share their experiences and deliberate upon the ideas related to the revised curriculum and its transaction to bring forth better professionals and effective Teachers.
