and other guidelines to implement it. Selected colleges will have to enter into a Memorandum

of Agreement (MoA) with TLC, TU. Detailed instructions and guidelines will be provided to

the selected institutions only.

Approved programs will have to be completed before 23 February 2019.

The proposals will be shortlisted after careful scrutiny by an empowered committee duly

constituted by the University.

Interested colleges may send detailed proposal duly signed by the designated Programme

Coordinator(s) and the Principal of the college for conducting the program. A soft copy of the

final proposal (scanned copy) must to be sent to tlc.tu@tezu.ernet.in. The colleges may also

send the hardcopy to TLC office. The basic instruction and selection criteria are attached

below.

Important Instructions

- **1.** The programme should be conducted for 6(six) days with 4 ninety minute sessions per day as per the schedule prepared by TLC. The schedule will be sent via email if requested by any applicant college.
- **2.** The proposal should include the following:
 - a) Details about college including name of local coordinator(s), organizing committee, drawing authority, legacy of the institution, previous experience in such programs etc.
 - b) Details about available infrastructure required for conducting such program.
 - c) Whether the location of the college suitable to attract participants from nearby colleges. (Connectivity)
 - d) Realistic budget adhering to UGC and MHRD norms regarding food, accommodation, travel allowance and honorarium to Resource Persons and Participants.
 - e) Willingness of the college to bear additional costs if proposed budget is over and above the amount to be sanctioned.
 - f) Supporting documents, photographs wherever required.
- **3**. Only Govt./Govt.-aided/Provincialized colleges offering UG/PG courses are requested to apply.

Selection Criteria

The decision on award of the training programme will be taken by a committee duly constituted by the University. The decision shall be mainly based on the following criteria. Any other criteria found appropriate by the screening committee may also be considered.

- 1. The cost of conducting the programme. (The budget is expected to be extremely realistic)
- **2.** Number of approximate participants (from surrounding colleges only , long distance participants should not be entertained if the colleges has no accommodation facility)
- **3**. Location of the colleges, and its connectivity with nearby colleges
- 4. Availability of suitable infrastructure.
