

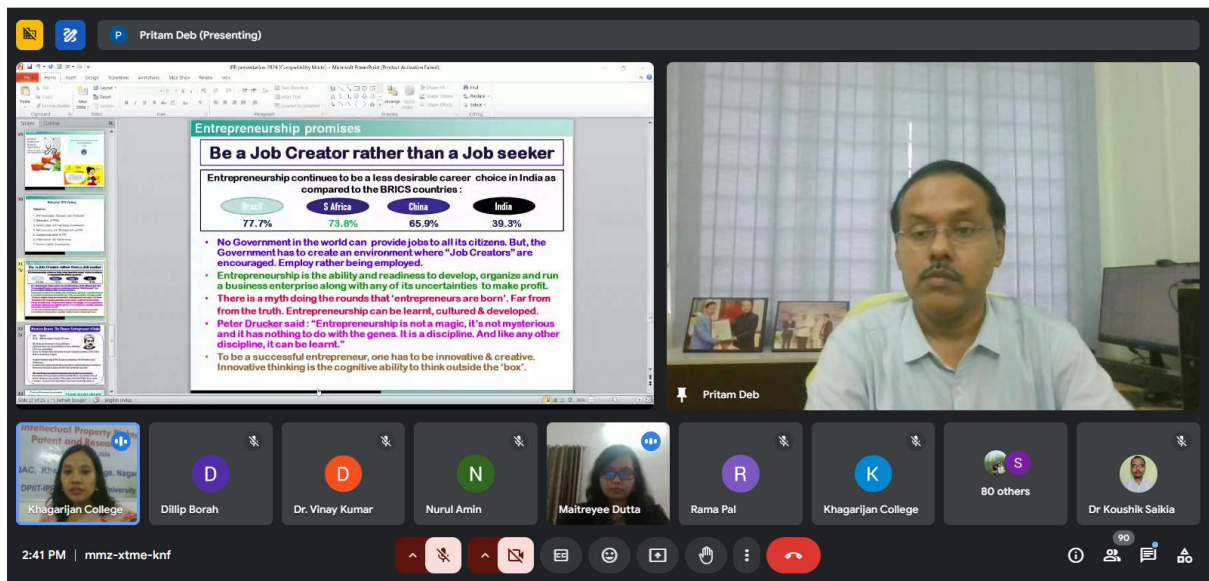


Figure 3: Screenshot of a session on 25/09/2024

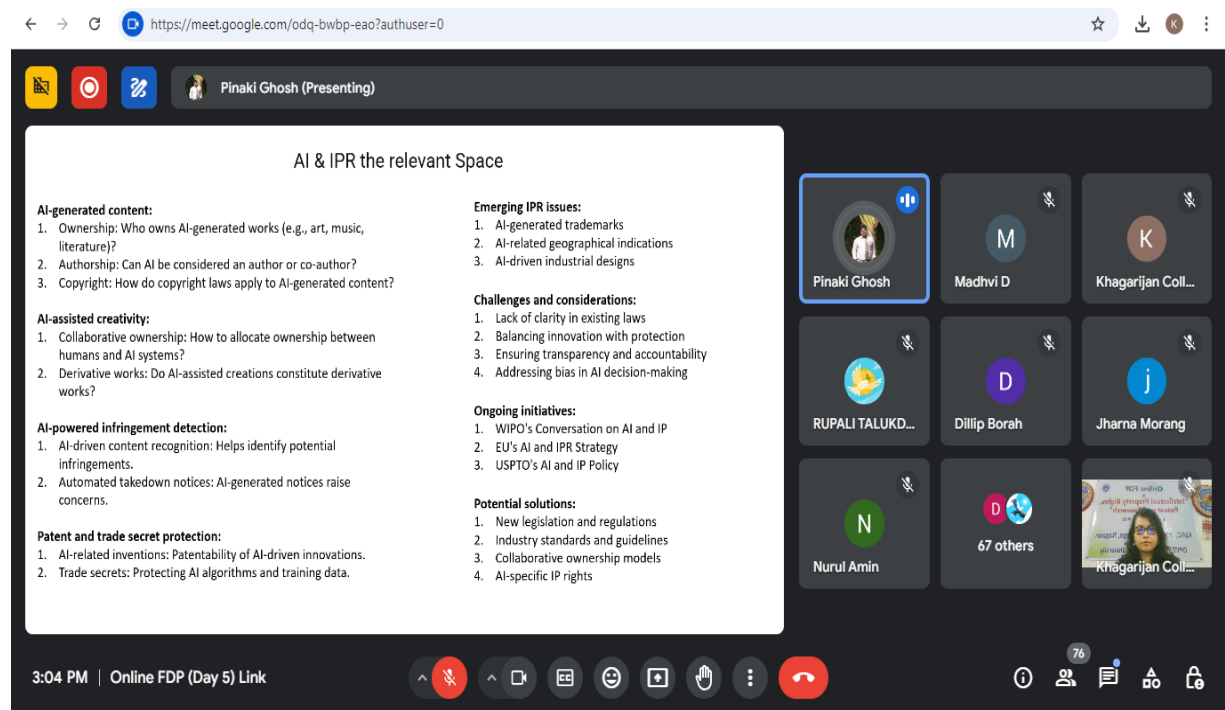


Figure 4: Screenshot of a session on 'IPR and AI'

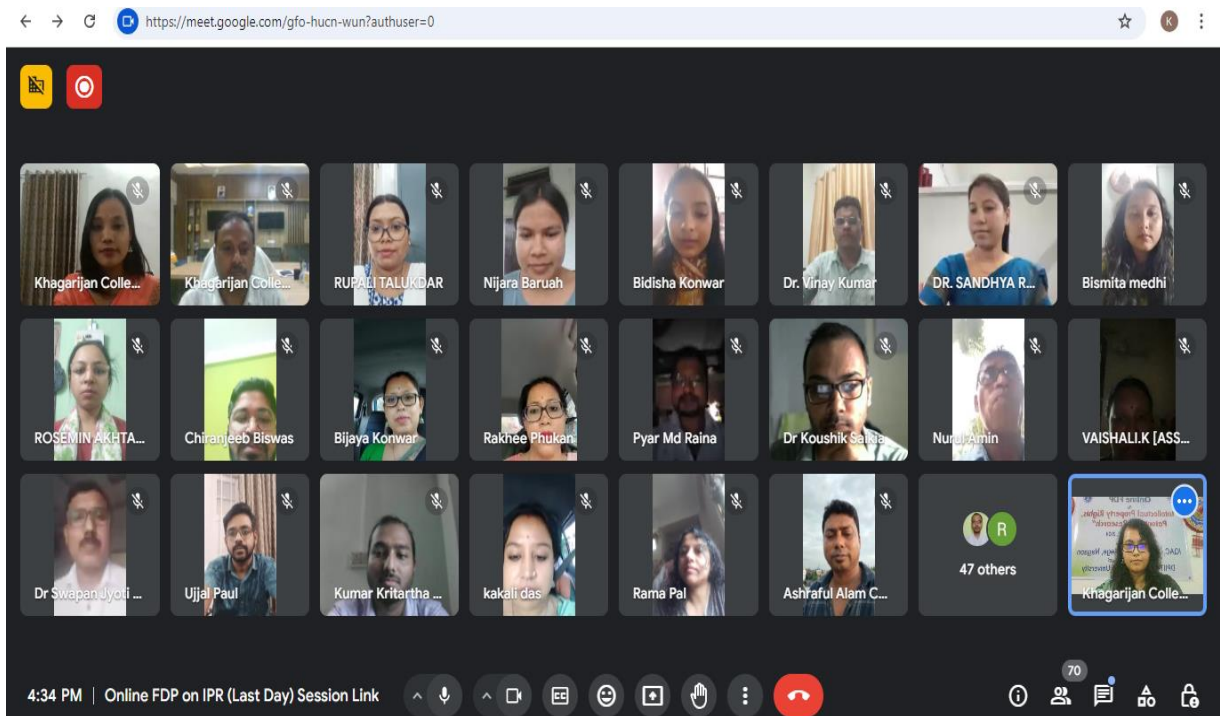


Figure 5: Group Photograph of the Participants

Overview of the Sessions

Inaugural Session:

The Inaugural Session of the FDP commenced from 1:15 PM on 25/09/2024. Bichitra Pegu, Coordinator, IQAC moderated the session. The Inaugural Address introducing the institution and the aim of the FDP was delivered by Dr Ramesh Nath, Principal, Khagarijan College. Mr Rayhanul Ahmed, Chief Coordinator IQAC and Convenor of the FDP informed the participants regarding the guidelines of the FDP. Following this, the Host introduced the Resource Person Prof. Pritam Deb who took over the technical session.

Sessions on 25/09/2024:

The first technical session scheduled on 25/09/2024 from 1:30 PM to 2:30 PM was spearheaded by Prof. Pritam Deb, IPR Chair Professor, DPIIT-IPR Chair, Tezpur University. He delivered an important lecture on “IPR in Academia and Industry-Academia Linkage”. He highlighted the bridging of the gaps that determine the success or failure of commercialization of any product and focused on features and economics of Intellectual property Rights. While demonstrating the linkage between Industry and Academia he also discussed the technology readiness level; addressing the gap between research and development. This was followed by an interaction on National IPR policy after which the platform was open for interaction.

The second technical session was on “IPR in Indian Context” by Dr. Mridul Dutta, Assistant Professor, Department of Business Administration, Tezpur University who highlighted the scenario of IPR and patents in our country. He spoke a great deal on various semblances of infringement bringing into focus the Assamese Entertainment industry as he emphasized on the concept of remakes by highlighting the famous film – Dr Bezbarua 2. Beyond this, he focused on Innovative Supply Chain as well as the Draft Assam Gamosa Heritage (Protection) Bill 2023; concluding the session with an intensive discussion on intellectual and revenue leakage followed by an engaging interactive session.

Sessions on 26/09/2024:

Dr. Koushik Saikia, Research Officer, IPR Cell, Tezpur University as the resource person of the first technical session of the day delivered his talk on “Issues and Scopes of IPR: Patent and Filing”. He focused on types of IPs, Scopes of IPR and discussed in depth about the patenting procedure and patentable inventions. He informed the participants about various Patent Search Databases and gave an overview of the Patent Application process in India, concluding with a discussion about the Patent Corporation Treaty (PCT). This was followed by an active engagement with participants who came forward with their queries regarding the patenting procedure.

The second technical session was on “IPR and Cultural Heritage Preservation” by Dr Juri Borbora Saikia, Research Officer, IPR Cell, Tezpur University. She introduced concepts like traditional cultural expressions (TCEs) and had an interactive brainstorming with the participants regarding the need to preserve cultural heritage symbols and systems. She spoke at length on the traditional Assamese ornaments and their cheap impersonations which threaten the local industry. She explained the GI tags and their role highlighting local Assamese culture and practices. This session was followed by various queries on the subject as participants requested for a longer session on this topic in the future.

Sessions on 27/09/2024:

Dr Tania Paul Das, Manager (Science and Technology) BioNEST, IASST, Guwahati delivered a talk on “IPR in Incubation and Entrepreneurship”. She deliberated on the roles of a teacher in nurturing the entrepreneurial spirit and highlighted the symbiotic relationship between Innovation, Intellectual Property and Entrepreneurship. Business idea conceptualization was a major portion of her discussion as she focused on the journey from ideation to production and commercialization of a product. With extra emphasis on incubation, she also threw light on patenting process and copyright. This was followed by an interactive session.

Mr. Siddhartha Devnath, Scientist – C, Patent Information Centre, Assam Science Technology and Environment Council on focused on the topic “Copyright” for the second technical session of the day. He gave an in-depth overview on the History of Copyright and various cases of infringements. Furthermore, he deliberated on copyrightable material focusing on creative works like literature, art work and music as well as the infringement and copyright issues related to it. This was followed by an interactive session where the participants engaged with the resource person on the subject matter.

Sessions on 28/09/2024:

Mr. Siddhartha Devnath, Scientist – C, Patent Information Centre, Assam Science Technology and Environment Council delivered another lecture on the topic “Trademarks”. He defined the category and criteria of trademarks highlighting the necessary requirements. He further informed the participants about classification of trademarks and gave an in-depth overview regarding registration of trademarks. After the session he engaged in an extensive interaction on various issues like Trademark infringement, use of AI in trademarks, service marks and trademarks as well as trademarking in virtual reality.

Dr Tapas Kumar Bandopadhyay, Associate Professor, Rajiv Gandhi School of Intellectual Property Law and Metallurgical and Materials Engineering, IIT Kharagpur delivered a lecture on “IPR Management and Policies, Legal Frameworks and Government Schemes” in the second technical session of the day. He emphasized on Economics and Features of IPR focusing on monopoly right, limited period right, property right etc. His session was followed by an active interactive brainstorming amongst the participants.

Sessions on 30/09/2024:

Dr Bula Choudhury, Senior Scientist and Coordinator, Entrepreneurs at Guwahati Biotech Park, IIT Guwahati delivered a session on “IPR and Entrepreneurship” where she focused on product innovation, process innovation and business model innovation. She highlighted

various avenues of technology transfer, fund support from Government schemes and Research Institutes. Incubation centres and their roles were another major point of discussion as she analyzed aspects of IP Valuation and IP Strategy. The participants engaged in an active discussion with the resource person as she also showed various initiatives of Biotech Park.

Dr Pinaki Ghosh, IPR Chair Professor, The West Bengal National University of Juridical Sciences, Kolkata delivered the second technical session of the day on “IPR and Artificial Intelligence”. He focused on technicalities of AI Generated content and ownership issues bringing into contemplation AI assisted creativity and infringement situations. He highlighted WIPO’s conversation on AI and IP, EU’s AI and IPR Strategy and USPTO’s AI and IP Policy. This was followed by interesting interactive session where various issues like AI generated content and AI assisted content were discussed.

Sessions on 01/10/2024:

Dr Sanjeev Kumar Majumdar, Senior Manager, IPR Startup and Incubation Division, National Research Development Corporation delivered a session on “Intellectual Property Strategies for Technology Commercialization”. He spoke at length about Technology Transfer and deliberated on NASA model for TRL Assessment. He highlighted the gaps in manufacturing innovation and explained the role of NRDC. He ended the session with various inputs on multiple success stories followed by an interaction with participants.

Dr Wazida Rahman, Assistant Professor of Law, Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab delivered the last technical session of the FDP on “IPR Protection of Traditional Knowledge in India”. She highlighted various issues and nuances that occur in the context of Traditional Knowledge in India and their protection from exploitation or piracy. Various legal frameworks were deliberated in the session highlighting their loopholes. She ended the session with a discussion on prominent patent dispute cases like Turmeric Dispute, Neem Dispute etc which was followed by an interactive session among the participants and resource person.

Concluding Session:

The technical sessions were followed by the Concluding Session of the Faculty Development Programme. The Moderator, Maitreyee Dutta, Assistant Professor, Dept of English, Khagarijan College announced the guidelines for certification followed by the Concluding Address delivered by Dr Ramesh Nath, Principal, Khagarijan College who gave a brief overview of the sessions and expressed his gratitude to DPIIT-IPR Chair, Tezpur University. After the address, various participants from different parts of the country expressed their views and described their experience regarding the FDP. The session concluded with a Vote of Thanks by Bichitra Pegu, Coordinator IQAC, Khagarijan College.
