


**Feedback Report- Autumn 2023 (Intellectual Property Rights in Research and Beyond:
IP750)**

Out of a class of 11 students, 8 students provided feedback on the CBCT course on IPR attended by Ph.D students. Highlights of the feedback response are presented as following:

- The students liked the way in which IPR topics were introduced in the classroom. They appreciated systematic way of teaching of the instructors.
- They appreciated the positive classroom atmosphere and use of multimedia to impart concepts effectively.
- The students liked the interactive session during the class.
- The students liked inclusion of web articles, journal readings, presentation, interactive sessions etc.as part of the learning in the class.
- The students liked the non-biased way of evaluation of the instructors.
- Students appreciated that the instructors were approachable for clarification of doubts.

Actions Taken:

- Some of the students want morning classroom schedules. However, placement of the class solely depends on availability of the schedule.
- Some students wanted more interactive sessions. We are taking note of the same and planning to incorporate more such sessions.
- Some wanted practical sessions for Patenting and GI. We are shortly planning to have one such session.


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
