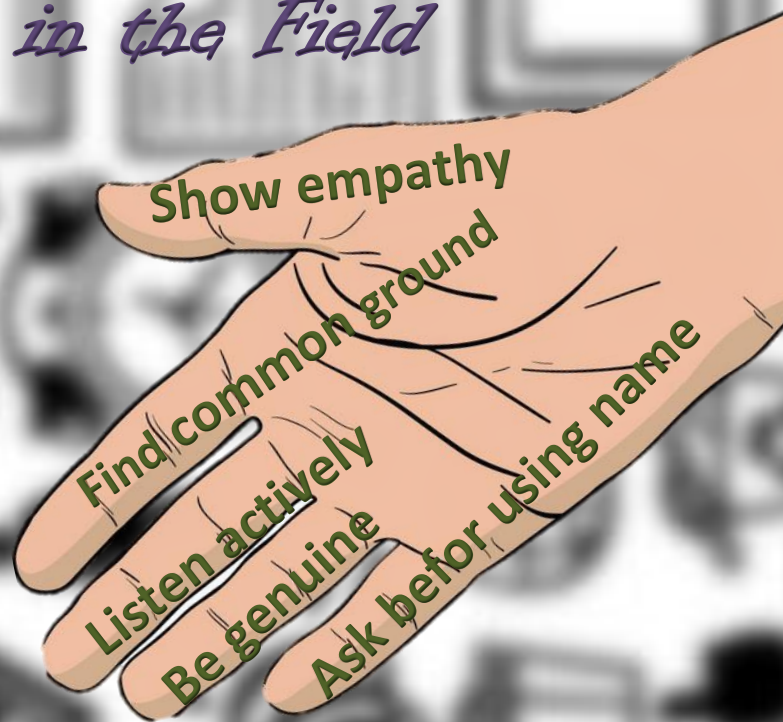

Plagiarism is copying or stealing someone's works, ideas and thought as one's own without proper acknowledgement.

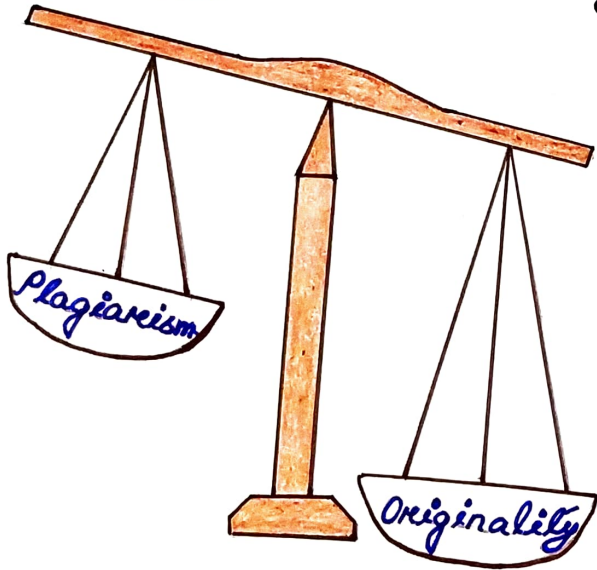
